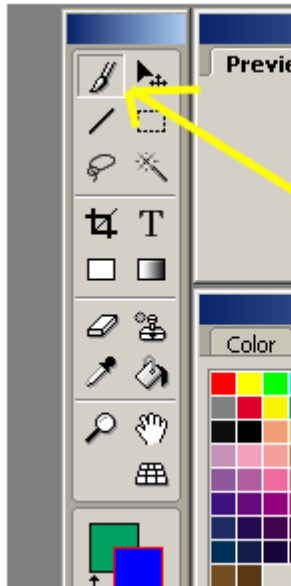
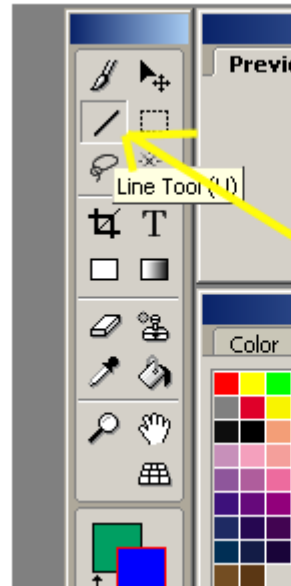


## Art Design Workshop, Week 6 – Freehand vs. Straight-Line Drawing

Look over the images below to familiarize yourself with the two tools we will be using today. the Brush Tool and the Line Tool.

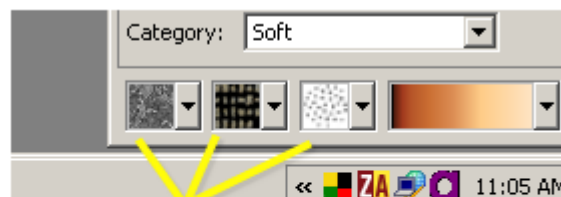


**Brush Tool

Ask students to open a new image (Ctrl+n) with the **640x480** preset size and then practice using both tools with assorted textures..



**Textures**

After some time practicing, students should start with a blank 640x480 canvas and begin creating their art. Make sure to use both the freehand and straight-line tools, assorted colors and textures for variety. Using design ideas from other art or photos, objects and/or letters in art is fine too.

More than ½ the class time should be spent on this project. Then, 15 minutes before the bell rings, ask students to print their art.

**Print with Preview > Page Setup > Landscape > OK > Print > Print**

Open Microsoft Word and do a write up about today's project, including name, date, project title (top of this page), describe what you learned and what it is you designed. Print this out and put in back of art in transparent sleeve/portfolio.
